Did you know? Heating and air conditioning do more harm to fine china than breaking the odd piece.

Have you ever seen crazing on fine china? It happens when pieces dry out. China should be immersed in water a few times a year to keep the crazing at a minimum.

It's good for china to soak. For cleaning, leave it in soapy water in the sink for awhile instead of scrubbing it - it's better for the china and you'll save yourself some elbow grease.

Another tip is to use a mat or dishcloth in the bottom of the sink so the china doesn't get chipped.
